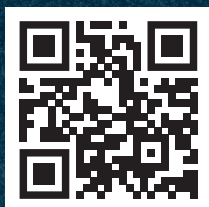

A Cinema in the park

The Edison Cinema is located in the heart of the historical core of the city of Karlovac, in the nearest vicinity of the protected historical complex – the unique six-pointed star. It is situated in beautiful public gardens and a spacious park where numerous buildings from the end of 19th and the beginning of 20th century can be found.

It is one of the oldest purpose-built cinemas in Croatia, built in the period from 1918 to 1920. The project was made by architects Bruno Bauer and Edo Schoen from Zagreb. With 490 seats, it was the largest cinema in Croatia, built in the romantic Art Deco style and named after the American inventor Thomas Alva Edison.

Cinema and more

The Edison Cinema proudly continues the tradition of the most cultural city in Croatia, as Karlovac was often called at that time. Namely, before the construction of the cinema, the first Croatian choral society as well as the first Croatian music school were established in Karlovac. The initiative to establish an Illyrian theatre – the future Croatian National Theatre started exactly from the city of Karlovac.

Today, the Edison Cinema is much more than just a cinema – it is a place of encounters, learning and entertainment. In the Edison Cinema you can watch the latest blockbusters and the most famous classics, but also participate in various conferences, famous festivals and numerous workshops. It is a multimedia centre that connects cultural heritage, audio-visual and performing arts and modern technology while providing an outstanding experience.

Halls and equipment

The Edison Cinema has a large and a small hall and a multifunctional space.

All halls are suitable for:

- holding a hybrid conference
- live streaming
- simultaneous interpretation
- presentation of VR content on wireless VR glasses for up to 70 people at the same time

Large hall

- a multifunctional hall consisting of a collapsible auditorium and a gallery
- capacity: 202 seats
- surface area: 240 m²
- stage: 24 m²
- professional stage lightning and sound system
- 4K laser projector
- cinema screen
- superb sound equipment

Small hall

- superbly equipped hall with luxury armchairs and larger space between the rows
- capacity: 42 seats
- surface area: 71 m²
- 4K laser projector
- cinema screen
- superb sound equipment

Multifunctional space

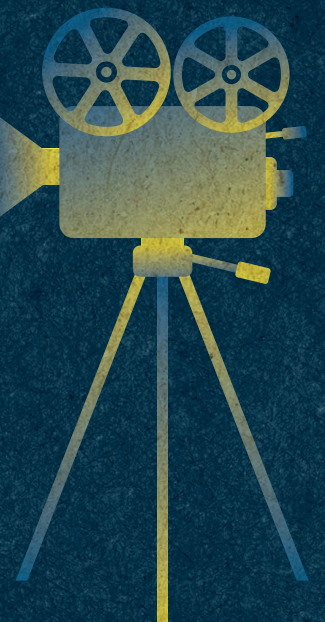

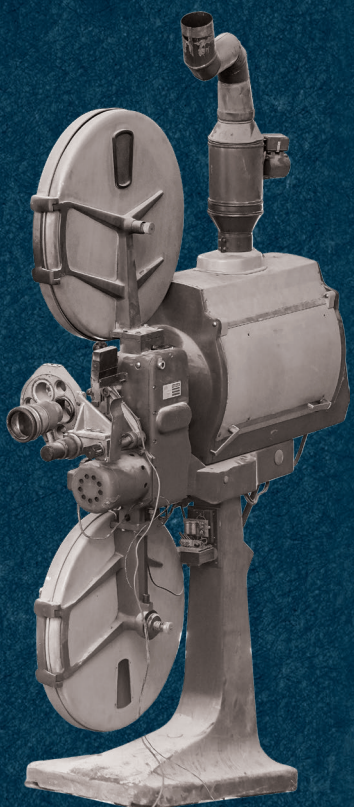

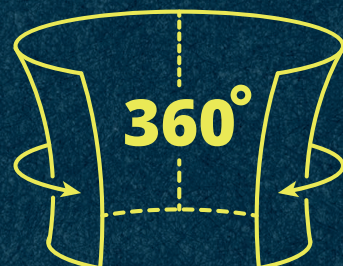
The exhibition space of the Edison Cinema gives you the opportunity of getting to know props from the glorious past of the cinema, while the **educational audio-visual studio** organizes workshops related to film art.

The café-bar within the Edison Cinema provides a pleasant ambience that is often thematically related to the content taking place at the cinema at the time, while the **souvenir shop** offers interesting memorabilia from the movie world and other souvenirs from Karlovac.

VR 360 and documentaries

Revitalisation project of the Edison cinema

The Edison Cinema was revitalized by the project „ITU – Revitalisation of the former Edison Cinema in the function of launching integrated tourist programs in the city of Karlovac.“ KK.06.1.1.17.0001. The project is co-financed by the European Union from the European Regional Development Fund, under the Competitiveness and Cohesion Operational Program 2014-2020.

The project holder is Karlovac City. The partners in the project are the City Theatre „Zora's home“, association Cinema club Karlovac and the Tourist board of Karlovac City.

The project implementation period is from November 2nd 2021 to May 2nd 2023. The total value of the project is 7.785.901,23 HRK, and the share of the non-refundable resources is 85%, i.e. 6.618.016,04 HRK.

The construction works on the building are carried out through the project „ITU – Renovation of the brownfield location of the former Edison cinema“, KK.6.2.2.18.0001. The project is co-financed by the European Union from the European Regional Development Fund, under the Competitiveness and Cohesion Operational Program 2014-2020.

The total value of the project is 7.785.901,23 HRK, and the share of the non-refundable resources is 85%, i.e. 21.949.849,85 HRK.

The project was started on April 6th 2021 and it ends on April 6th 2023.
